Changing the relationship between HIV Surveillance and Clinical Medicine

More than two decades of battles over HIV surveillance yielded a comprehensive public health surveillance system — along with robust threats to protect confidentiality. Many surveillance personnel and advocates for people with HIV assumed that such negative threats should be used for espionage purposes only — that data would go but not come out.

Despite such deep resistance, pressure began to mount to ensure that surveillance data were used to serve public health ends. In 2007, a report from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) clearly stated that "once the data are in hand it is the failure to use those data for public health purposes that must be justified."
